

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO EU REGULATION 2016/679

Dear User, we wish to inform you that the EU Regulation 2016/679 (“GDPR”) provides for the protection of individuals with respect to the processing of personal data. RoomD, as “Owner” of the treatment, pursuant to article 13 of the GDPR, therefore, provides you with the following information:

DATA CATEGORIES: we will process the personal data released in the mandatory and optional fields. We will also treat the information freely given in the free compilation field. Please do not release information of a specific nature or information relating to third parties or, obviously, sensitive statements of the decorum or dignity of others.

OBLIGATORY OR LESS CONFERRAL OF DATA: We inform you that the provision of data is mandatory for some fields (marked by the asterisk symbol “*”) and their failure to provide them will result in failure to send the form and, therefore, the impossibility to receive and satisfy your request. Failure to provide data in the optional fields as well as a partial or incorrect release of data, may make it impossible to fully or correctly fulfill your requests.

SOURCE OF PERSONAL DATA: Personal data is collected directly from you when this form is sent.

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS: the processing of data in relation to the compilation of this form has as its legal basis the need to satisfy pre-contractual requests of the interested party (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b of the GDPR) as well as the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to process requests for information requested by the interested party (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter f of the GDPR).

DATA RECIPIENTS: Within the limits relevant to the purposes indicated, your data will be processed by subjects authorized to process and manage corporate communication. For exclusive reasons of technical assistance to the site or to the IT system of the Data Controller, the data may be accessible to authorized IT personnel. The hosting service providers / applications / IT platforms that host this site and the resulting communications are responsible for the technical storage of data and are identified as Data Processors pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR. Your data will not be disseminated in any way.

TRANSFER OF DATA ABROAD: the data collected is not disclosed abroad. However, all requests and messages sent to the Data Controller spontaneously to e-mail addresses or in filling in the web forms on the site can be tracked / stored on servers located outside the EU or the European Economic Area (EEA) belonging to the platforms. third party we use; consequently, it is possible that your personal data are transferred to subjects or companies located outside the EU or the European Economic Area (EEA). In these cases, or if the need arises to make use of other types of non-EU suppliers who have access to some of your personal data, the Data Controller will provide you with full information and will verify that all appropriate and necessary measures (contractual and otherwise) have been adopted to guarantee an adequate level of protection of your personal data in accordance with and with the methods indicated in Chapter V of the GDPR and, in any case, by the current legislation on the protection of personal data. DATA PROCESSING METHODS: The personal data you provide will be processed with IT tools in compliance with adequate technical and organizational security measures suitable for preventing the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

STORAGE PERIOD: The data collected will be kept for the time necessary to fully process your request and to keep track of it in case of any developments, after which they can be deleted.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY: Pursuant to Chapter III of the GDPR, the interested party always has the right to request the Data Controller to access your data, to rectify or delete them, to limit the processing or to oppose the processing, to request data portability, to revoke (where requested) the consent to the processing by asserting these and the other rights provided by the GDPR by simple communication to the Data Controller. Finally, the interested party has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if he believes that the processing that concerns him violates the legislation applicable to the protection of his data.
