

COOKIE POLICY

In accordance with the provisions of the General Provision of the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data of 8 May 2014, users are informed on how to manage cookies on this site www.roomd.it (the "Site").

WHAT COOKIES ARE

"Cookies" are short text files that are downloaded to the user's device when a website is visited. At each subsequent visit, the cookies are re-sent to the website that originated them (first-party cookies) or to another site that recognizes them (third-party cookies). Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device. They have different purposes such as, for example, to allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember your favorite sites and, in general, improve the browsing experience. They also help analyze the use that users make of the site (analytical cookies) or to ensure that the advertising content displayed online is more targeted to the user and his interests (profiling cookies). While browsing the Site, the user may access third-party features or platforms - of which RoomD is in no way responsible - which may release cookies and collect personal data.

COOKIES USED ON OUR SITE

Within our site we use both technical cookies and cookies issued by third parties (analytical and profiling).

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those installed directly from our Site with the aim of making it easier to navigate and use the services offered and to save preferences in order to customize navigation, interface, language, etc. Since these cookies are installed directly from our Site and are not used for any purpose other than those described above, their installation does not require your consent.

Third party cookies

Within our Site (on all pages or only in some of them) there are also third-party cookies [whose installation requires your consent and, in the absence of the same, they will not be installed]. We remind you that browsing our sites is equivalent to expressing your consent to the installation of cookies and even third-party cookies mentioned here can be installed from our sites within your browser. Beyond this, the user is free to provide personal data by sending spontaneous communications to the telephone or e-mail addresses on our sites. Failure to provide them, partially or incorrectly may make it impossible to obtain what is requested.

THE “OWNER” OF THE TREATMENT

CATEGORIES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data

The computer systems and computer programs used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the website, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user’s IT environment. The navigation data will be collected exclusively in the legitimate interest of allowing the user to use the content published on the website of the owner and its proper administration and management. These data are kept for a short time and could be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of hypothetical computer crimes against RoomD. Thereafter, the data are stored only in anonymous form for the sole statistical interest.

Data provided voluntarily by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender’s address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message. PROCESSING METHODS AND SUBJECTS AUTHORIZED FOR PROCESSING

The treatments connected to the web services of this site (physically placed in “hosting” at the server located in Europe of -----) take place both at the headquarters of Holder. The control and custody of information are handled by authorized personnel responsible for accepting online requests. The data may occasionally be accessed, for exclusive technical reasons, by authorized personnel who provide assistance to the site and to the IT systems of the Data Controller. No data deriving from web browsing is communicated or disclosed to further third parties except in compliance with legal obligations.
